









## M&E Framework and System for the Private Sector Development Programme (PSDP)



## **Brief Overview of the assignment**

- The overall objective of the assignment is to design and develop a Results based Monitoring and Evaluation System for the Private Sector Development Programme within the framework of the overall Private Sector Development Strategy
- Monitoring of the PSDP will be at micro, meso and macro level
  - Result Area 1-Micro Level-Value chain analysis and SMME development
  - Result Area 2-Meso-Enhanced capacity of SMMEs and IOs, TSIs and BDSPs
    ;and
  - Result Area 3-Macro-Improved Business Environment for Enterprises.
- Some key outputs will be
  - Development of Monitoring and Evaluation Framework System for the PSDP;
  - M/E capacity building for implementing institutions such as BOCCIM, MTI etc;
  - Development of a Web Portal; for both M/E system, information dissemination on best practice, lessons learnt and achievements to stakeholders.
- Several potential risks in the form of human resource and technical inadequacies are envisaged but mitigation measures have been put into place.

Phase 1-Development of the M/E Framework

Phase 2-Training of BOCCIM, MTI, IOs, Service provider staff on the developed M&E System

Phase 3-Follow up of the Implementation of the developed M&E System

Phase 4-Implementation of Exit Strategy
